As the conductor punches tickets, riders enjoy a special holiday trip to the North Pole (Wintergreen) where Santa's Elves serve hot cocoa and sing songs. Everyone gets to decorate sugar cookies, visit with Santa, and take home a jingle bell souvenir.
